THE LESBIAN, BISEXUAL + GAY PRIDE COMMITTEE OF REGINA believes it is important to recognize the hard work done in the Queer community. Many people in our city have volunteered countless hours of time and resources to make Regina a safer and saner place to be Queer, but all too often that work goes unrecognized and unnoticed.

WE'RE ABOUT TO CHANGE THAT. This year we will present the fourth annual REGINA PRIDE AWARDS to four worthy Regina citizens:

- 1. LONG-TIME COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD FOR A WOMAN** who has made a significant contribution to the health and well being of our community.
- 2. LONG-TIME COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD FOR A MAN** who has made a significant contribution to the health and well being of our community.
- 3. MAN OF THE FUTURE** for a youth (under 25 years old) who has shown leadership and made a significant contribution to our community.
- 4. WOMAN OF THE FUTURE** for a youth (under 25 years old) who has shown leadership and made a significant contribution to our community.

HELP US CHOOSE THE WINNERS. On the other side is a nomination form for the REGINA PRIDE AWARDS *for* COMMUNITY SERVICE. Please fill it out naming who you think deserves an award and why you think they deserve one. **Each nomination form requires the signature of a co-signer and the signature of the person being nominated** (*so we know you have their permission to nominate them*). We also need your phone number in case we require clarification on any point and a contact number for the nominee in case he or she ends up getting an award. Once you've filled out the form, return it by no later than May 31, 2002 to either:
